

Georgia Mentor Protégé Connection Privacy Policy

What personally identifiable information is collected on this site?

Visitors may supply personally identifiable information (such as name, address or telephone numbers) for various purposes on this site. These purposes include registering to receive e-mail or newsletters, registering for a conference or event, requesting further information about our services, or simply asking a question about the Georgia Mentor Protégé Connection (GMPC). The GMPC does not collect personal information from you unless you provide it to us. This means that you can visit our site without telling us who you are or revealing any personally identifiable information about yourself.

How is it used?

When you supply information about yourself for a specific purpose, we use the information for only that purpose (such as to provide the event registration, service or information you have requested). For example, you may be asked to give us individual information to receive information, manage online services, or apply for a job.

The GMPC does not sell or share e-mail addresses or other information you provide with outside sources.

Should any material changes be made to the ways in which we use personally identifiable information, GMPC will take commercially reasonable measures to obtain e-mail consent from you. We will also post the changes to our use of personally identifiable information on our site at least 30 days prior to any change.

Security

Personally identifiable information is stored on our server and is not publicly accessible. Further, personally identifiable information is only accessed by GMPC employees on a "need to know" basis. All GMPC employees must go through privacy training upon starting with the GMPC. The GMPC meets or exceeds all industry standards for the protection of personally identifiable information.

Choice/Opt-out

What anonymous information is collected on this site?

Anonymous information is collected from every visitor to this site. This includes pages viewed, date and time, and browser type. IP numbers are not stored, but are temporarily used to determine domain type and in some cases, geographic region. We do not make any association between this information and a visitor's identity.

How is it used?

The information is used by the GMPC to build anonymous behavioral profiles, which are written to the GMPC Knowledge Database, securely housed at the GMPC data center. These profiles are accessed to offer you personalized content and promotions, and to target relevant, more interesting content, all without knowing your identity. Again, there is no association between a GMPC Knowledge Database profile and a visitor's identity.

How does this site use cookies?

The GMPC uses cookies to identify your browser as you visit pages on the GMPC site or sites in the GMPC media network. Cookies allow the GMPC to gather anonymous information. Cookies also allow the GMPC to provide more relevant, targeted content as you travel through sites in the GMPC media network.

For users who prefer not to have their Web usage information reflected in the GMPC Knowledge database, the GMPC provides an opt-out procedure.
